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DoN HBCU/MI Program

Overview

- The DoN HBCU/MI Program is the leading naval force for identifying and connecting with innovators and scholars at Minority-Serving Institutions

Priorities

- Engage HBCU/MI faculty and students in naval-relevant research, fellowship, and internship opportunities
- Help MSIs build naval-relevant research and education capacity

Alignment with FY16 NDAA, Section 233

- Broader inclusion of faculty and students in research and internship opportunities within the Naval Research Enterprise (NRE) and warfare centers
- Engagement with and support of MSIs in developing STEM capabilities as they relate to naval Science and Technology (S&T) challenges



STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES

NAVAIR Internship Program

- 6 to 8 week research opportunity for HBCU/MI students
- Research topics specifically focused on naval aviation

NRL Internship Program

- 10 week research opportunity for HBCU/MI students
- Research topics span all STEM disciplines

SPAWAR Cybersecurity/Information Assurance Program

- 6 to 7 month program in which HBCU/MI students work on teams to explore mission-critical cyber-related initiatives
- At least one DoN SPAWAR technical professional on each team

NAVSUP Internship Program

- 8 to 10 week research opportunity for HBCU/MI students
- Research topics specifically focused on data science and logistics engineering

*Programs in blue are specifically for HBCU/MIs



FACULTY OPPORTUNITIES

Summer Faculty Research Program (SFRP)

- 10 week research opportunity for U.S. faculty members
- DoN laboratory or warfare center
- May through August

Sabbatical Leave Program (SLP)

- 6 to 12 month research opportunity for U.S. faculty members
- DoN laboratory or warfare center
- Academic school year

Faculty Startup Program in Materials Science and Engineering

- Start-up funding supplement designed to help institutions attract top talent in materials science/engineering (Co-sponsored with Kenny Lipkowitz, Code 33)
- Proposals submitted by provosts (as PIs) with deans as co-PIs
- Funding level varies with institution

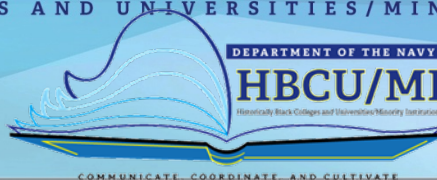
